1. Hillside Ordinance

R. Lata, Community Development Director

Consider the range of options regarding possible further amendments to the City's Hillside Grading and Development. The Commission and Council will review the content and implications of the City's current adopted Hillside Grading and Development regulations, and what portions of the City could be impacted by hillside grading. Discussion will include public and Council concerns with recent grading activity and what types of regulations could best address the various concerns.

OPTIONS

- a. Leave the current Hillside Ordinance in place during the two-year General Plan up-date program, using that time to evaluate what additional refinements are warranted. During this period, it is recommended that the City require applicants to submit more detailed information as a part of their subdivision and development applications (e.g. models and computer simulations), and that more stringent requirements for landscaping installation and maintenance be applied. (This is the approach recommended by the Commission.)
- b. Circulate a Request for Proposals to hire a consultant to comprehensively re-write the City's Hillside Grading and Development Ordinance. It is estimated that this work could be accomplished for between \$30,000 and \$50,000, including public workshops. (The actual cost may vary and would depend upon proposals received.)
- c. Identify specific changes that should be made to refine the existing ordinance, to be prepared by staff without a comprehensive re-write of the ordinance.
- **d.** Amend, modify or reject the above options.
