

## RESOLUTION NO.6.

## Resolution Calling for Special Election.

Whereas, this Board has duly passed an Ordinance providing for the levying and collection of a tax for the purpose of providing funds for Park, Music and for Advertising purposes; and

Whereas, said Ordinance is of no effect until the same shall have been submitted to the electors of this City at a special election to be held for that purpose, and ratified by a majority of the votes cast thereat.

THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby resolved that a special election be held in said City on Thursday, the 30th day of August, 1923, and that the Clerk give notice of said election as required by law; that at such election said Ordinance be submitted to the electors of this City for rejection or approval; that there be one voting precinct established for the purpose of holding such election, consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts established for holding the last general State and County election, as follows: Consolidated voting Precinct "A", comprising State and County precincts Paso Robles No.1, Paso Robles No.2 and Paso Robles No.3; that for the purposes of said election the following persons are hereby appointed the officers to conduct the same, to wit:

Inspector: W.S.Eddy

Judges: J.W.Mitchell, Mary E.Fowler.

Clerks: Lillian B.Patriquin, Mabel Bilton-Kitchen.  
that the polls at said election be open from 10 o'clock A.M. to 6 o'clock P.M. of said day, and the polling place be the Fire House Building on 13th. Street.
