

## RESOLUTION NO. 151.

Adopted March 16, 1931.

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RESOLUTION DECLARING THE WEEDS ON CERTAIN  
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS TO BE NUISANCES

Be it, and it is hereby resolved, that pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled: "An Act Authorizing Municipalities to Declare Noxious or Dangerous Weeds Growing Upon the Streets or Sidewalks, or Upon Private Property, Within Municipalities, To Be a Public Nuisance, Creating a Lien Upon the Property Fronting Upon Such Streets or Sidewalks, or Upon Which Such Nuisance Exists For The Cost of Abating the Same," approved May 28th, 1915;

It is hereby declared that the weeds now growing upon the streets and sidewalks of this City hereinafter specified, attain such large growth as to become a fire menace when dry, and produce seeds of a noxious character, and the same are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and the Superintendent of Streets shall, after the passage of this resolution, post notices as under Section Three of said Act provided.

That said streets and sidewalks and the property in front of which such nuisances exist are described as follows, (the lot and block numbers or other designation of said property given herein, as well as the names of the streets, are according to the official map of said City,) to wit:
