RESOLUTION DEGLARING THE WYFICE OF CERTAIN
WERETE AND SIDETALKS TO BE DYNAMORS

Be it, and it is hereby resolved, the trummant to an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled: "An Act Authorizing Municipalities to Declare Nowlous or Dangerous Meeds Growing Upon the Streets or Sidewalks, or Upon Private Property, Within Municipalities, To Be a Public Muisance, Creating a Lien Woon the Property Fronting Upon Such Streets or Sidewalks, or Upon Which Such Muisance Exists For The Cost of Abating the Same," approved May 25th, 1915;

It is hereby declared that the weeds now growing upon the streets and sidewalks of this City hereinafter specified, attain such large growth as to become a fire menace when dry, and produce seeds of a novious character, and the same are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and the Juperintendent of Streets shall, after the passage of this resolution, post notices as under Section Three of said Act provided.

That said streets and sidewalks and the property in front of which such nuisances exist are described as follows, (the lot and block numbers or other designation of said property given herein, as well as the names of the streets, are according to the of icial map of s id City,) to vit:
