RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES SETTING THE TAX RATES AND APPORTIONMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1942.


BE IT RESOLVED that the tax rate for the fiscal year 1942-1943 be and the same is hereby fixed at \$1.10 for each One Hyndred Dollars of assessed valuation of this City, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tax rate of \$ 1.10 on each One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation of the assessable property of the City so fixed as the tax rate for the fiscal year 1942-1943 be apportioned as follows:

GENERAL FUND	\$.77
LIBRARY FUND12
WATER BOND REDEMPTION FUND08
RESERVOIR & SEPTIC TANK FUND13


BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER that pursuant to Ordinance No.69 NS, Section No.601, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby levy the city taxes on the assessable property of the City of El Paso de Robles in accordance with the rates and proportions hereinabove fixed.
