RESOLUTION NO. 482

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles did acquire by private sale from the Tax Collector of San Luis Obispo County on August 1, 1938 property described in deed Number 4375 accepted by Resolution Number 314 and deed Number 4376 accepted by Resolution Number 315 said deeds and resolutions being recorded in Volume 243 at pages 314 and 315 respectively of the Official Records of San Luis Obispo County, and

WHEREAS, it now appears that descriptions in said deeds included property that had been an erroneous double assessment by the County of San Luis Obispo and not subject to the conditons of said sale.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be authorized to execute a quit claim deed to James Rude, Charles Rude, John Rude, Leo Rude and Mildred Morgensen as heirs of Emma A. Rude, deceased, the property referred to and particularly described as follows:

"That certain tract of land lying partly within the boundaries of the City of El Paso de Robles, according to map filed for record October 25, 1889, in the office of the County Recorder of said County, lying between the East line of Lot 6 in Block 64 of said City and the established boundary line between the Rancho El Paso de Robles and the Rancho Santa Ysabel and bounded on the North by the Easterly extension of the North line of said Lot 6 and on the South by the Easterly extension of the South line of said Lot 6."
