

RESOLUTION NO. 1100

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles, California, that it be and it is hereby ordered and determined as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction and completion of the following municipal improvements to wit:

(a) The acquisition, construction and completion of a sanitary sewage pumping station and trunk sewer mains and the acquisition of easements necessary therefor.

(b) The acquisition, construction and completion of a municipal swimming pool together with bath houses, structures and facilities appurtenant thereto, and the acquisition of lands necessary therefor.

Section 2. That the improvements mentioned in the foregoing section of this resolution are necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of the City.

Section 3. That the cost of said improvements mentioned in said preceding section and each of them severally and respectively, will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary accumulation of income and revenue of the City.

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
