

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE TAX RATES AND APPORTIONMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75

WHEREAS, the final budget of the City of El Paso de Robles for the fiscal year 1974-75 having been approved and adopted; and

WHEREAS, the assessment rolls for the City of El Paso de Robles for the fiscal year 1974-75 are now being completed by the County Assessor with an estimated net valuation of \$16,963,249.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the total tax rate on taxable property within the City of El Paso de Robles for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July, 1974, be fixed at \$2.54 on each One Hundred Dollars of the assessed valuation as established for city tax purposes and shown upon the assessment rolls.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all city taxes collected on each One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation at the rate of \$2.54 be apportioned to the several City Funds as follows:

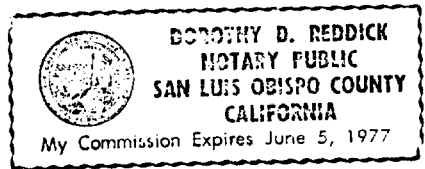


