

RESOLUTION NO. 2306
A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR
CLOSING A STREET IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AND
GIVING NOTICE OF TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON

The CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve
as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City Council to close and vacate a portion
of 34th Street from Park Street to the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way
in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California,
and more particularly described as follows:

Parcel A

Commencing at the southeast corner of Park Street and 34th Street in the
City of El Paso de Robles as shown on the map recorded in Book "A",
page 169 of maps, in the office of the County Recorder of the County
of San Luis Obispo; thence

First:

N 86° 10'00"E 228.4 feet to the southwest corner of Pine Street and
34th Street, said corner also being the beginning of a tangent curve
with the westerly line of Pine Street (50), concave to the southwest
having a radius of 15 feet; thence

Second:

northly and easterly along said curve an arc distance of 23.56 feet and
through a central angle of 90°00'00" to a tangent line; thence

Third:

S86°10'00"W 198.4 feet on a tangent line to a tangent curve concave to the
southeast having a radius of 15 feet; thence

Fourth:

Westerly and southerly along said curve an arc distance of 23.56 feet
and through a central angle of 90°00'00" to the point of beginning.

Parcel B

Commencing at the northeast corner of Park Street and 34th Street in
the City of El Paso de Robles as shown on the map recorded in Book "A"
page 169 of maps, in the office of the County Recorder of the County
of San Luis Obispo; thence

First:

N86°10'00"E 287.77 feet to a point on a non-tangent curve concave to the
northwest having a radius of 88 feet, a radial line of said curve through
said point bearing N37°46'53"W; thence

Second:

Southwesterly and westerly along said curve an arc distance of 52.14 feet and through a central angle of $33^{\circ}56'53''$ to a tangent line; thence

Third:

$S86^{\circ}10'00''W$ 223.63 feet on said tangent line to a tangent curve concave to the northeast having a radius of 15 feet; thence

Fourth:

Westerly and northerly along said curve an arc distance of 23.56 feet and through a central angle of $90^{\circ}00'00''$ to the point of beginning.

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference is hereby made to a map and plan now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles.

3. That June 19, 1979, at the hour of 7:30 p.m., on said date in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 1030 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objections to the proposed closing.

4. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published fifteen (15) days prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Paso Robles Daily Press, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of El Paso de Robles, California.

5. The Director of Public Works of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place set for hearing thereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the street proposed to be closed.


