

RESOLUTION NO. 12-102

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES CITY COUNCIL  
ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE  
FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA)  
TO PREPARE AN UPDATE OF THE CITY'S HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
AND APPROVING MATCHING FUNDS TO QUALIFY FOR THE GRANT

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WHEREAS, FEMA has awarded the City of Paso Robles a grant, to be administered through the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA), for the purpose of funding an update of the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP); and

WHEREAS, HMPs are intended to reduce the likelihood of hazardous disasters from occurring and reduce the impacts should they occur; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared its first HMP in 2005, and they are required to be updated every five years to be eligible for hazard mitigation grant programs and FEMA emergency funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has secured a grant (\$28,133) to pay for the majority of costs associated with updating the HMP. The City would hire a qualified consultant to prepare the Plan update; and

WHEREAS, a 25 percent matching fund is required to accept this grant, and the City's grant request includes \$7,500 in-kind staff services and \$1,900 cash for materials to meet the matching fund requirement. The cash contribution would be appropriated to General Fund expenditure account 100-710-5212-398.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of El Paso de Robles approves a one-time budget appropriation of \$28,100 to expenditure account 100-710-5224-398; \$1,900 to expenditure account 100-710-5212-398 from General Fund Reserves; and \$28,100 to revenue account 100-000-4618-398 for the Grant proceeds and use of in-kind staff services for the balance of the City's matching fund to process this project and administer the grant.

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
